
HOI is a registered charity providing support for six schools, 900 children, 3000 women in empowerment groups and 32 village health centres. HOI will return in 2024 for their 18th year of service.



HOI encourages experienced chiropractors who enjoy being part of a diverse group, keen to share their services, knowledge and skills, to join 2024 team.

New graduate chiropractors who join the team benefit from intense “hands-on” chiropractic experience working alongside and supported by their experienced colleagues.

Over the nine clinic days, HOI expects to provide around three thousand chiropractic treatments. The team will also visit women’s empowerment groups, schools and health clinics.



What can you expect on your 12-day journey?

17 February: Team meeting and welcome dinner Delhi, India

18 February: Fly as a group to Bagdogra, transfer to Siliguri and join our host, Seva Kendra.

19 - 23 February: Travel each morning via jeep to clinics in the tea plantation and rock breaking communities to provide chiropractic and health services. Afternoons may involve school visits, women's empowerment meetings and health clinic visitations. Evenings will include organised group dinners, CPD sessions and casual arrangements.

23 February (afternoon) – 25 February: Travel to Darjeeling for weekend rest and rejuvenation. Enjoy the mountainous tea region with an optional Himalayan sunrise experience.

26 - 29 February: Continue working in village clinics and schools.

28 February: HOI Bollywood celebration team dinner.

1 March: Fly from Bagdogra to Delhi and continue home/travels.

OPTIONAL (and highly recommended) side trip to Agra and The Taj Mahal prior to the trip (additional cost involved)

15 February: Arrive Delhi

16 February: Depart early morning for overnight trip to Agra & Taj Mahal.

17 February: Return to Delhi for the HOI team meeting.
